

REGISTRATION OF NON-EU CITIZENS*

Art. 1

- (1) The application file for admission to study at the Bucharest University of Economic Studies (ASE) has to be sent to our University. Non-EU candidates can apply within a maximum of two years from the date of passing the bachelor's exam. After submission, the application file will be checked by the University. Subsequently, depending on the language of instruction, the procedure is as follows:
 - a) **Programs taught in English and German:** The application file will be forwarded for analysis and approval to the Ministry of Education and Research, which will issue the Acceptance Letter. The Acceptance Letter will then be transmitted to the applicant by the University's International Relations Department.
 - b) **Programs taught in French:** The application file will be verified and then forwarded to the admission team of the study program Entrepreneurship and Business Administration (in French). The admission team will conduct an online interview with the candidate, which will conclude with a "Pass" or "Fail" decision. The interview will assess the candidate's general economic knowledge, motivation, and communication skills in the language of instruction (French). The interviews will be scheduled March-September 2026. Only the files of candidates who receive a "Pass" decision will be forwarded for analysis and approval to the Ministry of Education and Research, which will issue the Acceptance Letter.
- (2) This letter allows the applicant to apply for the study visa from the **Romanian Embassy** in his/her country.
- (3) It is recommended to apply as soon as possible because the procedures for obtaining the acceptance letter and the visa procedure may take up to 30 days each.
- (4) **The application file must contain the following documents (certified/authorised translations into English or Romanian):**
 - a) Application form with photo;
 - b) Copy of the Baccalaureate (high school) Diploma or equivalent and the transcript of records for the high school years endorsed by the Romanian Embassy in his/her country or with the Hague Apostille – translated into Romanian, English or French and officially endorsed;
 - c) Copy of the Bachelor's diploma and the transcript of records, endorsed by the Romanian Embassy in his/her country or with the Hague Apostille – translated into Romanian, English or French and officially endorsed;
 - d) Language certificate for the language of instruction;
 - e) Copy of the birth certificate – translated into Romanian and officially endorsed;
 - f) Passport copy;
 - g) Medical certificate stating that the applicant is fit for university studies.

Art.2

- (1) If the applicant doesn't speak Romanian and the chosen program is taught in Romanian, he/she should learn Romanian during a preparatory year.
- (2) For the applicants who wish to study in English, French or German and are not native speakers should provide a recognised language certificate.
- (3) Applicants shall mention in the application their complete contact details (physical address, e-mail address, telephone number).
- (4) Documents should be sent by e-mail **internationaladmission@ase.ro**.
- (5) The registration and tuition fees are decided each year by the Academic Senate of the university and might be subject to change at the beginning of each academic year.
- (6) Upon arrival in Romania, the accepted applicant will have to register personally at the Bucharest University of Economic Studies, having the following documents:
 - a) The letter of acceptance in original;
 - b) Bachelor diploma and the transcript of records for the bachelor studies, endorsed by the Romanian Embassy in the country of origin with the Hague Apostille) – in original and translated into Romanian, English or French and officially endorsed;
 - c) Baccalaureate (high school) Diploma or equivalent endorsed by the Romanian Embassy in the country of origin with the Hague Apostille–in original and translated into Romanian, English or French and officially endorsed;
 - d) Transcript of records for the high school years in original and translated into Romanian, English or French and officially endorsed;
 - e) Language certificate for the language of instruction – if applicable;

- f) A copy of the birth certificate, translated into Romanian, English or French and officially endorsed;
- g) Medical certificate (translated into Romanian or English) stating that the applicant is fit for university studies;
- h) The passport containing the study visa.

Art. 3

Schedule for admission: receipt of application files: 01 March - 29 August 2026 student registration: 08-30 September 2026 (registration will be complete after the receipt of the original documents and the completion of a language test, when applicable, according to the law and regulations in force).
